Autism West Social Group Program – Term 2, 2017

We see incredible potential for young people with Autism.

Using a strength-based approach, Autism West facilitates [social groups](#) for children and young adults on the spectrum between the ages of 10 and 30 years old, across 3 locations in Perth; Mosman Park, Marangaroo and Fremantle.

Now supporting nearly 100 young individuals with an ASD weekly during the school term and many more 5-18 year olds throughout the school holidays in our Telethon Holiday Makers Program.

Centred around individuals interests, our social groups are planned and developed with active involvement from our participants and facilitated by experienced Autism West staff.

Special Interests Programs

We cater to a variety of special interests as determined by our participants. In 2017 we will be exploring:

Coding and Lego Robotics – Learn through mini challenges using the common languages used in code! Our Dojo's are hoping to enter a team into Robo-Cup 2017!

Digital Media – Explore digital photography and film making with local young film maker Phillip Butland.

Visual Arts – Artist in residence, Olivia Colja, joins the team to nurture those with an interest in art and creativity.

Music – We are excited to be collaborating with Pirate Radio and Music Rocks on our new Music Program exploring music, how to produce a radio program, and becoming a DJ!

Telethon Holiday Makers Program

A social group tailored according to the support needs, ages and individual interests of 5-18 year olds with an ASD. This is a great introduction into our social groups and our holistic strengths-based approach for participants with low and one to one support needs.
